### What type of poetry do you write (traditional, experimental, etc)

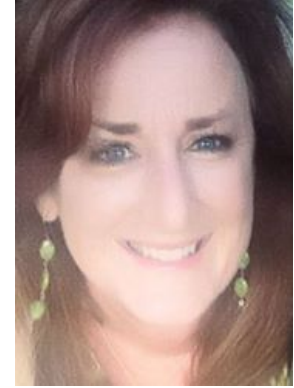
I guess most of my poems would be classified as lyrical or narrative free verse. I've experimented some with the sonnet and villanelle forms.
