Timothy Guilfoy was accused of molesting the children of a renter at a home he owned in Clarksville, TN. The first trial ended in a hung jury. The second trial ended in a lengthy sentence. The jury was provided evidence during deliberation that was not presented in court.

The two main issues in Timothy Guilfoy's case:

1) Videos were provided to the jury that had not been presented in court, were never viewed by Judge Monte Watkins, were never shown to Timothy Guilfoy or his attorney prior to, during or after the trial. Jury member, Hilary Hoffman, has come forth verifying this activity.

2) James O. Martin III, accepted a position with DA, Glenn Funk, months prior to presenting Timothy Guilfoy's post conviction appeal. Mr. Guilfoy had no knowledge of Mr. Martin's decision. at the time of the appeal. Mr. Martin has admitted to this violation. This action is a violation of the Board of Professional Responsibility (BPR) code of ethics.

In 2016, Chicago-based attorney, Kathleen Zellner, reviewed Mr. Guilfoy's case. Ms. Zellner understood what happened in this case and agreed to represent Mr. Guilfoy.
